

CV Claus Sørensen

I originally trained as a reflexologist in 1997 and then moved on to study Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine at the College of Integrated Chinese Medicine, UK, headed by John and Angela Hicks and Peter Mole, from which I graduated in 2002. Two years later I got the opportunity to attend a degree top up course earning me a university degree; the first dane to achieve a degree in Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine :-). My dissertation looked into overgrowth of candida yeast infection and how it could be diagnosed with Tongue Diagnosis and Shen-Hammer Pulse Diagnosis/Contemporary Chinese Pulse Diagnosis.

Since 2004 I have used what in Europe is known as the Shen-Hammer Pulse System as my main diagnostic tool. In 2011 I attended an advanced intensive seminar with Dr. Leon Hammer, and in 2012 I was the first Scandinavian to become fully certified as an CCPD instructor.

I'm particularly interested in Dr Shen's System model and the correlations to Liu Jing, a topic I have taught extensively in Europe including the Rothenburg Congress.

I have integrated the pulse system into the acupuncture training program at Nordic Acupuncture College, Denmark.

I'm also a trained chinese herbalist. In 2016 I graduated from a 2,5-year programme from Southern College of Chinese Medicine. Lund, Sweden, run by Louis Womack. I enrolled in the GMP2018 (Graduate Mentorship Programme) which has impacted my clinical work deeply. I graduated and got certified by Sharon Weizenbaum, and now I have also taken on the roll as TA (teaching assistant) in upcoming GMP's.
